Sports Premium Funding

What is Sports Premium?

The Sports Premium is the Government's policy to provide new, substantial primary school sports funding. Its aim is to see money go directly to primary schools to spend on improving the quality of sport and PE for all of their children. The sports funding can only be spent on Sport and PE provision in schools, but it is the schools' freedom to do so as they best see fit.

How will Grange Primary Academy be spending the Sports Premium Funding and who will benefit?

The school believes that the money should be invested so that all children benefit regardless of their sporting ability, that the most-able children are given wider opportunities to compete in advanced tournaments and that staff have access to training opportunities and continued professional development.

Our Aims & Priorities.

- To ensure that there is high quality first teaching and learning in all PE lessons to meet the needs of each individual pupil at Grange Primary Academy.
- A consistent approach to the teaching and learning of the PE and sport curriculum across the school using the Real PE resources
- To develop an increased understanding in parents and pupils of the importance of leading a healthy lifestyle.
- To develop, encourage and celebrate a love for taking part in sport in school.
- To increase participation in a range of sport at all levels within the school and community for pupils of Grange Primary Academy.
- To develop and improve facilities and resources for PE
- Varied and active playtime and lunchtime for all pupils.

Grange Primary Academy Sports Premium Funding for 2016-2017 was £8865

The school used this in the following ways:

KS2 Swimming - £2310 The impact of this was that 95% of our children leaving at the end of Year 6 could swim 25m. 70% of this year's class have already achieved that.

Kettering Sports Partnership membership - £3000 – This has enabled us to increase our participation in school games events for all year groups.

Sports Coaches - £7748 – This has helped to widen the range of clubs and sports that we are able to offer and provide high quality coaching to our children.

Extra-Curricular Clubs - £200 – This has enabled us to remove barrier that children may have faced accessing clubs.

The school however spends considerable more than the funding we receive on PE and Sports provision.

Grange Primary Academy Sports Premium Funding for 2017-2018 is £17,710

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Evaluation of our Spending

Grange Primary Academy will evaluate the effectiveness and impact of the funding through qualitative methods through pupil voice, staff voice and parent voice. We will also use quantitative methods such as data analysis on participation rates and progress in PE. This will be carried out on an ongoing basis throughout the year and more formally at the end of the year to inform next years spend.
